The stalls and field events on a sunny afternoon placed around the main ring give the Carnival that special community feeling and it is walking around here that many of us bump into each other for a chat while the children play with each other, bounce on the bouncy castles, climb the Climbing wall, do the lucky dip, shoot some arrows and browse around the other stalls. We hope that the 2011 Carnival will provide as wider a variety of stalls as the 2010 event. The stalls and raffles raised just over £2,000.

It is easy to forget that the Carnival is supported by the Coffee shop. Jamie and his family provide the essential bar facilities that much of us used during the weekend. There is much unseen work that is done by Jamie and the Coffee shop staff and the Committee is indebted to them for supporting the Pennard Carnival again and for providing the much needed sustenance throughout the day and into the evening!
